This serie of inter-chapter BIF sessions was born from the firmness of a group of Transparency International European chapters (TI France, TI Greece, TI Italy, TI Slovenia, TI Spain, TI UK and TI Sweden) in the need to promote the exchange of knowledge, challenges and best practices among their different European BIFs and its members in areas such as transparency, integrity, good governance, ethics, compliance, corruption prevention and sustainability, among others.

This session is held in commemoration of the International Anti-Corruption Day (IACD), a globally recognized initiative dedicated to raising awareness about the urgent need to combat corruption in all its forms.
